We put everything in its right place: waste that is properly separated can become a great resource.

Separating waste properly is important, because it can **be recycled and transformed into other products**, therefore reducing the use of raw materials.



ORGANIC

ORGANIC WASTE GOES IN THE BROWN BIN

Kitchen waste should be put in the brown bin, using compostable biodegradable bags.

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

raw or cooked leftover food, fruit and vegetable skins and waste, meat and fish waste including bones, pasta and flour-based products, bread, rice, fruit stones and pits, seeds, house plant remains and leaves, shells (of eggs, walnuts, hazelnuts), camomile and tea bags, coffee dregs, corks, used paper napkins and tissues dirties by food residue.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

lawn and hedge cuttings, garden waste (grass, leaves), animal faeces, food packaging paper (greaseproof, plastic-coated or aluminium), cigarette butts, liquids, oils, chemical products, rags, wood, ashes (from fireplaces or barbecues).

Tetra Pak containers for liquids are not to be placed in the yellow sacks but in the waste paper bins.



PLASTIC GOES INTO THE YELLOW SACK

Plastic packaging materials must be placed in the yellow sacks. No other container may be used.

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

bottles used for mineral water, milk, soft drinks and oil, bottles and dispensers for detergents, soap and cosmetics, sauce, creams, yoghurt and ice-cream tubs, food trays (in PET, polystyrene and polypropylene), blister packs and other pre-shaped packaging, bags and packs for pasta, potato crisps, sweets, vegetables and frozen foods (including those with an inner silver lining), fruit and vegetable nets, transparent film, retail bags and carriers shops, garden product sacks, containers for animal detergents and foodstuffs, small pots used for the

sale and transportation of flowers and plants, materials for protecting and carrying merchandise (film, bubble wrap, polystyrene chips), disposable plates and glasses (with no residual food), all-plastic coat hangers.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

toys, trainer shoes, plastic shoes, mats, plastic furnishings and artefacts, DVDs, CDs, music and video cassettes, photographs and photographic film, pens, umbrellas, disposable razors, garments, jerry cans, buckets, toothbrushes.

REMEMBER: to empty, rinse and/or clean and then flatten the containers.

GLASS AND METAL

GLASS AND METAL GO INTO THE BLUE BIN

Glass and metal must be placed in the appropriate blue household bins supplied, without using bags of any kind.

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

bottles, glasses, jars, glass vases and carafes, food containers for storage and freezing, tins and tubes for food, cans used for soft drinks and liquids, aluminium foil, jars, metal coat hangers, metal bottle caps, aerosol spray without the hazard* label, coffee pots.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

ceramic plates and cups, incandescent and low consumption light bulbs, neon tubes, mirrors, ceramic glass containers (such as Pyrex) or ceramic ware, crystal glasses and objects, plastic bags, aerosol spray cans labelled with the hazard* symbol, window pane glass, car window glass, the glass of car headlights, glass packaging used to contain medicines, television tubes, TV screens, monitors, stones, building materials.

PAPER GOES INTO THE WHITE BIN

Paper and cardboard must be placed in the white bin, folded and flattened to save space.

Alternatively, paper can be put out in cartonplast containers or in tied bundles or cardboard boxes

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

newspapers, exercise books and magazines (without any adhesive, metal or plastic parts), Tetra Pak packaging (of the type used for milk, fruit juice and other beverages), paper bags, cardboard tubs and trays for food, cardboard packaging for toys and clothing, pizza cartons without any residual food attached.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

dirty paper with food residue, fax paper or noncarbon copy paper, receipts, greaseproof paper, plastic-coated cards, cellophane wrappings, pizza cartons with residual food attached, plastic bags.

UNSORTED WASTE

UNSORTED WASTE GOES IN THE GREEN WHEELIE BIN

All waste that cannot be recycled should be placed into the green bin supplied.

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

dirty paper, greaseproof paper and sandpaper, broken plates and ceramic ware in general (in small quantities), non-electronic plastic toys without batteries, CDs, DVDs, music cassettes and video cassettes, vacuum cleaner filters and disposable bags, babies' nappies, sanitary towels, sticking plasters, disposable razors, cigarette butts.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

batteries, oils, drugs, dangerous substances and their containers (glue, paint, solvents, insecticides), low consumption and neon light bulbs.

PLANT WASTE

**PLANT WASTE GOES INTO THE GREEN WHEELIE BIN
ALTERNATIVELY, WASTE CAN ALSO BE PUT OUT IN

WHAT TO DISPOSE OF:

grass clippings, cut flowers, waste from tree and hedge pruning, vegetable residues from gardening.

WHAT NOT TO DISPOSE OF:

plastic, cellophane and nylon bags, plastic vases.

WARNING:

Materials must be placed in front of your home in the appropriate container or in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres long and weighing less than 15 kg each. You can put out a **maximum of 12 total packages, between bundles and bins.**

It is forbidden to use sacks of any kind for the collection of plant waste.

...and what about everything else?

There's a place for any type of waste, even for granny's old sofa or the TV remote batteries.



COMMUNAL ECOLOGICAL PLATFORM

For the citizens of Gazoldo degli Ippoliti, the Ecological Platform on via Aquileia 2 is available.

WHAT YOU CAN BRING

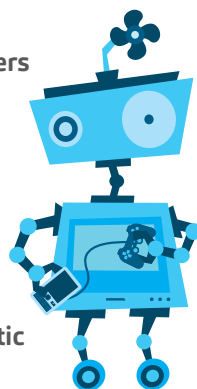
- Bulky waste: furniture (wardrobes, tables, armchairs, sofas, bed nets, chairs), different objects (mattresses, kitchen furniture, household plants), non-household Bulky waste (bicycles, canoes, scrap metal), Bulky waste that derives from small renovations (doors, windows, shutters, carpets, sinks)
- disused durable goods: refrigerators, freezers, televisions, computers, washing machines, dishwashers, air conditioners, water heaters, WEEE in general*

* WEEE

All household appliances and technological products, of all types and sizes, which need an electrical plug or batteries to work.

For example: refrigerators, washing machines, televisions, computers, monitors, mobile phones, cameras, video games, MP3 players, irons, blow dryers, blenders, vacuum cleaners, etc.

- used batteries
- green waste and waste from pruning
- low consumption fluorescent lamps (to be disposed of intact)
- car batteries
- frying oils and fats
- used toner cartridges
- tyres
- glass panes
- iron (pieces of disassembled furniture, small objects)
- wood (boards, parts of furniture, boxes)
- products and containers labelled with the hazard symbol**
- paints and varnishes
- paper and cardboard
- plastic packaging
- glass and metal
- mineral oil for domestic activity
- medicines



WARNING: if they are not disposed of properly, WEEE is a source of serious pollution in the air, water and soil.

The electric and electronic waste collected is delivered to the various authorities for the recovery of materials

**** On containers of hazardous waste you will see these symbols:**



TOXIC

fly killers, acids, thermometers, bactericides, enamel paints, freezing products, rat poison, weed killers, insecticides, caustic soda, disinfectants.



IRRITANT

bleach, ammonia, trichloroethylene, nitro-synthetic enamel paints, turpentine, car detergents, stain removers, glue, car body paints, mastic, thinners, adhesives.



INFLAMMABLE

Aerosol sprays, stain removers, solvents, zinc-based anti-rust, glue, enamel paint, nitro-synthetic enamel paints, anti-mist agents, thinners, gloss paint for furniture, ethyl alcohol for liquors, car polish.



CORROSIVE

batteries, acids, chemical drain cleaners.

Clothing in general, if still in good condition and clean, can be placed into the curbside containers distributed around town.

These containers are managed by da Onlus, who arrange to empty them every week and reuse their contents.

BULKY WASTE

Bulky waste, such as furniture and appliances, can be brought to the Ecological Platform on via Aquileia 2. As an alternative, a free home collection service is available, exclusively for domestic users, upon reservation. Up to 15 reservations can be received at one time. The collection is carried out on the second



Tuesday of even months (excluding holidays). A maximum of 7 packages will be collected. The evening before the day agreed for collection, the waste to be disposed of must be put out on the street or on the pavement in front of your house, positioned in a place accessible to the collection vehicle and avoiding creating an obstacle for vehicle and pedestrian traffic. No collections from cellars, attics or other premises or rooms within properties are carried out. Reservations can be made by calling the **freephone number 800 437678, from Monday to Friday from 8 to 20 and Saturday from 8 to 15.**

The collection of **babies' nappies** and **adults' sanitary pads** is reserved for users who have specific needs (children up to 3 years of age, people who are bed-ridden or who have specific recognised illnesses that require them) with the prior authorisation of social services.

The collection is carried out with **orange bags**.

TARI INFORMATION DESK

The waste tax (TARI) information desk is available for citizens to:

- request changes to their use (opening, variation, termination);
- withdraw the bins in case of justified need (integration, replacement, loss or theft) and return the bins following the termination of their use;
- get information and explanations on the operation of the tariff system, on the content of invoices and on the methods for paying the fee;
- get information on the minimum guaranteed collections of the unsorted waste.

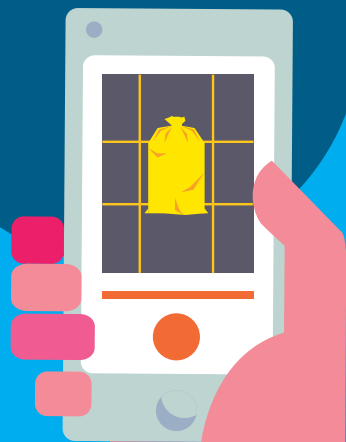
